Dear Parents

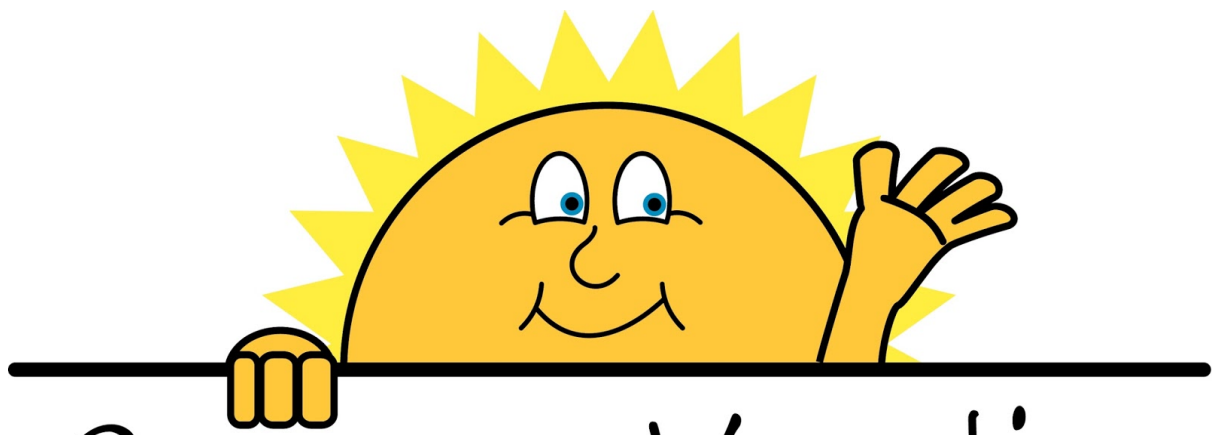

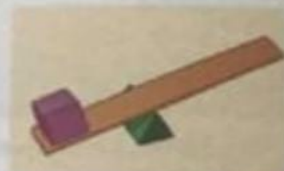
